3 PLANNING APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

SE/00638/FUL STONEHOUSE FARM, STONEHOUSE LANE, TN14 7HH

Demolition of two dwellings and agricultural buildings and erection of two replacement dwellings

Halstead Parish Council objects to this planning application for the following reasons:

- 1: The Parish Council believes that this application contravenes Policy GB4 of the Green Belt policies as the design and volume proposed materially harms the openness of the Green Belt due to the excessive scale, bulk and visual intrusion.
- 2: The development also contravenes policy L08
- 3. Several of the outbuildings are more than 5 metres from the main dwellings, which contravenes the 5 metre rule and this should only be ignored if there are very special circumstances.
- 4. The new buildings will be considerably higher than those currently on site; the plans indicate that these two houses will have three storeys.
- 5. Council is surprised that the applicants wish to demolish a property that was only built in 2002.
